## Ofsted 'Outstanding' in every category

We are very proud to report that, on completion of a very rigorous 6-day inspection between June and November, our teacher training programme was judged by Ofsted to be Outstanding in every category.



The inspection team considered our provision to be a national benchmark for teacher training providers, and highlighted how effective we are in supporting school improvement in the region.

During the November inspection, they visited last year's trainees as Newly Qualified Teachers in their employing schools including Fleetwood High, Longridge High, Aspire Academy and Montgomery. Every NQT was judged as being "fully equipped with the tools required to teach". They described our "wrap-around, bespoke care of NQTs" as one of our "unique selling points".

We would like to thank every school, every leader and every mentor for their complete commitment to our programme and our shared vision to grow our own teachers. The report stated that our "exceptional levels of communication permeate every aspect" of our work and that is down to our partnership and the positive relationships we have. So thank you!
