Who are we?

We are the Fylde Coast Teaching School, a wider strategic alliance established by The Blackpool Sixth Form College and Hodgson Academy. We were awarded Teaching School status in 2011, one of the first 100 teaching schools, and unique in terms of a cross phase commitment from primary, secondary, sixth form and special education.

Entry requirements

The essential requirements for the Secondary programme are:

- A first degree 2.2 or above
- Grade C or above in GCSE English Language, Mathematics and Science or a qualification in each of these subjects recognised by the University of Cumbria as being an equivalent. These must have been awarded prior to application to this programme
- 2 GCSE grade C or above in a Primary National Curriculum subject
- Effective communication skills in spoken and written English
- Up to 10 days recent and relevant work experience in a Primary School environment
- 2 written references, one of which must be academic in nature

Please note that your original certificates – Degree, A Level and GCSE or equivalent will be required to be produced at interview.

What Age range will I teach?

Your teaching experience will be in both Key Stage 3 (Age 11-14) and Key Stage 4 (Age 14-16) and you will be qualified to teach these age ranges. Enrichment experience will also be provided in a sixth form, a special school and a pupil referral unit. You will also carry out a one week placement in a primary school.

How will I be supported?

You will be extremely well supported throughout all elements of the programme. Induction will be provided before the programme commences and at each school that will host your classroom based training and practice. You will be assigned a subject mentor and professional mentor who will support, guide and coach you on a day to day basis.

How do I Apply?

Applications for Initial Teacher Training (ITT) courses are made via a system administered by the Universities and Colleges Admissions Service (UCAS).
